St. John Neumann parish is very pleased to introduce an opportunity for our youth to receive a Catholic Education through the **Saint John Neumann Catholic Education Scholarship Fund**. This scholarship fund is available to all Parish families and those youth who are sponsored by an active member of our church. Its mission is to provide tuition assistance for religious education programs and Catholic schools.

All who are interested must apply by May 10th. Scholarships will be awarded in July based on a combination of need and merit. Our goal is to award as many scholarships as possible to our parish youth, so we strongly encourage you to consider what you can afford and what amount you would require when requesting your desired scholarship amount.

Listed below are general questions and answers regarding the Scholarship Program. If you have additional questions please feel free to contact one of the committee members. We hope and pray the availability of this Scholarship Fund will allow those seeking a Catholic Education to continue or start the journey of learning within our Catholic Faith.

What if I already have a child(ren) in a Catholic school – can I apply?

Your application is welcome if you feel you are unable to keep up with the rising cost of tuition rates or if you need help due to a loss of a job, health issue, etc.

Do you have to be a Most Blessed Sacrament Catholic School student?

No – this scholarship has been established to further all forms of Catholic and Religious Education, including Religious Education classes, High School, College, and more.

How is this scholarship awarded? Is it confidential?

A Review Team appointed by the Pastor will conduct the review process. The Team will score and rank the applications and present their findings to the Pastor. All personal information (name, address, etc.) will be marked out to provide for anonymous review and recommendation for the distribution of scholarship funds. All applications will be kept confidential between the Committee Chairs, the Pastor, and school/religious accounting office as appropriate (awards are paid directly to the institution).

Will volunteer service influence the decision of the Review Committee? What type of volunteer work does Saint John Neumann need?

Yes – part of the scholarship is merit based and the Review Committee will take all service into consideration. There are many areas of need at the church, whether it's joining a committee, selling 50/50 raffle tickets or shopping cards, setting up or cleaning up at an event, coordinating activities, collecting recycling, etc.; scheduling is flexible.

How do I apply for the SJN Catholic Education Scholarship? What's the due date?

*Applications can be downloaded from the website at www.stjohnneumannrcc.com or picked up in the Parish Office. They are to be filled out completely and returned to the office in a sealed envelope marked "Application for St. John Neumann Scholarship Fund". **The deadline for applications is May 10th for the following school year.***

Are there other sources of tuition funding available?

Yes, there are many. Here are just two: the diocese of Wilmington conducts the "Share in the Spirit" tuition Assistance program. If you currently have children enrolled in a Catholic school, the school will send a notice home when application packets with complete instructions are available. If your children are new to a school, application packets will be available at registration. The Knights of Columbus organizations offer scholarships to pursue a Catholic education.
