ELECTRONIC GIVING PROGRAM

At the request of many of our families, we are happy to introduce the St. John Neumann Electronic Giving Program which will be offered to our parishioners beginning July 1, 2009. It is a direct payment program which is a safe, smart, and a green way to make your contribution to our parish.



Electronic giving allows you the freedom of setting up the weekly, monthly, or quarterly contributions to support your church and having it automatically debited from your checking or saving account and electrically deposited into the parish account especially setup for that purpose.

Also known as “Direct Payment” in the commercial world, it is reliable, accurate, on time, and confidential. If a problem occurs, it’s easy to resolve – just by calling the Parish Accounting Office. Electronic payments are protected under Federal Reserve regulations.



As always, the traditional use of bringing your weekly envelope with your cash or check contribution will always be accepted. And, for those of you who use your computers to pay bills, here is another way. You might prefer to establish through your own bank a “Reoccurring Bill Pay” account on your own which will allow you to make your contribution automatically. If you need more information on this option please contact our Business Office.
